Here's another example of how a dentist replaces missing teeth. In this case, with an overdenture – anchored to two dental implants. This is quite different from a conventional denture because it is permanently stabilized in the mouth.

This course of treatment is just one of several options, so consult your dentist to find the best solution for your individual condition.

installing an overdenture on implants.

1. installing the implants –

The first step is installing dental implants to secure the overdenture. Only two implants are needed.

2. attaching the overdenture –

The overdenture is securely fixed on top of the implants. They will be removable for cleaning and oral hygiene.

3. the beautiful result –

At last, there's no need to worry about a slipping, sliding or clicking denture. You're free to enjoy life.
